

The book is so well written that it is easy, even for my 11 year old, to follow the directions. The book contains patterns for many different types of projects: animals, centerpieces, games, decorations, toys and more. The ideas are clever and fun to make. The items are all inexpensive to make using materials such as paper plates, egg cartons, chenille sticks, straws, poster board with crayons, paints, glue and tape to help decorate. If you don't happen to have the material on hand that is called for, it is easy to substitute something else. This is a fun book full of activities that will keep your children busy and creative for hours.

Paper plates are one of my favorite craft materials and this book certainly is chock full of ideas. After you start making some of the crafts included in this book, you'll begin looking at paper plates in a whole new way. And the kids will soon be coming up with their own ideas. Actually, I've come to count on the whole series of "Look What You Can Make From...." I've got three of these books on my crafting bookshelf right now!
