

I bought this darling book for my granddaughter, aged 4 ... and then decided I should recommend it to my clients. I'm an EQ coach and I love the attitude of this book. We should all have our dreams and wear our tutus everywhere -- if not in reality, in our minds. Who knows what you can grow up to be if you keep envisioning your dreams, and it's never too late, and you're never too old.

My 5 year old received this for Christmas and it is her new favorite book. She practices the dance moves shown in the pictures while wearing her own pink tutu...the story is delightful, the pictures bright. Great for any dance lovers...

For every little girl starting at age 1. I can't stop reading it to my 3 year old. It's very up to date in the illustrations and has cute tones! Just change "Mama" and "Papa" to "Mommy" and "Daddy" and it's the perfect story to read to your little one. Short and sweet.

We first purchased this book a few years ago when our oldest daughter was about 3 1/2 years old and she would wear a tutu EVERY day to school, shopping, etc. She often looked "silly" (just like Tilly in the book) but she was happy and she loved the idea of being a ballerina. This book perfectly captured the intensity of her desire to dress how she wanted. It really was a precious time in her childhood. We even framed an illustration out of the book and have it up on her bedroom wall because it so wonderfully captured who she was during those pre-school years. I wear my Tutu Everywhere is a great book for all those pre-school wanna-be ballerinas. We read it many times over and highly recommend it!

I bought this for my two-year-old who has become obsessed with two things -- ballerinas and books. What a perfect combination! This book could have been written about her! The storyline is simple, easy to read and has a great message. It should prepare her for dance class next fall. It is sure to become a favorite in our home.

We just happened upon this book at the library. After the second page I realized this book was talking about my daughter!(or any little girl who loves to dance and loves pink!) After maxing out our renewal limit on the book, my husband and I decided to purchase the book for our little one for her 3rd birthday. We love it!

This book is not as helpful as other reading railroad books. The other books are based on a set of 24 or so similar or rhyming words that repeat throughout the book, this one has very few repeating words. It even uses french dancing terms like *jeté* and *plié* and *réleve*. How is even a first or second grader supposed to figure those out? It is a cute story, but it shouldn't be billed as an early reader book. Don't buy this if you are looking for books to ease your kids into reading, it is more of a bedtime story read by mom or dad.

This is a very cute book. I wanted a little gift (other than flowers) to give to my 5 year old granddaughter after her dance recital and I thought this filled the bill nicely. She hasn't really commented on it - everything was a little chaotic that day - but I thought it was really cute - so I was pleased to give it to her and it commemorates the day.
