

wiggling... Story starts with school librarian and a book in the library, she has it opened to a page with dinosaurs in it. They jump out of the book and start doing all sort of various school things within the library, classroom and playground. At the end of the story they jump back in the book again. Really cute idea for a child's story

I gave it 5 stars, but since I had it sent to my 5 yr. old granddaughter, I really didn't see it. But she takes dancing lessons and is eager to learn to read, I thought this would be a great book for her. I think she liked it.

My son is 25 months and can tell me what is happening in the pictures. The story line is easy enough for him to follow. He asks to read Dinos go to School! Worth the \$4.00.

My six year old nephew loved it. He loves dinosaurs though. The book contains lots of rhyming words. It does run a little long so if you have a child that has a hard time focusing you may want to read half at one time then half another time.
