

Just got it today and read it to my kid. She's still a bit too young to fully grasp what's going on in the books (she's 3) but loves to have me read them to her. Glad to see there's more coming! And please keep them coming too.

I really, really like this book and have recommended it to many friends. First, I love the I Am... historical biography series. We own all of them and I think the series is excellent and I wish there were more. I loved the focus in this book on the importance of curiosity and inquisitiveness in Einstein's life, and how the series highlighted how certain influences, like exposure to a medical student who was staying at his home, proved important factors. My only possible complaint -- while I love how the book makes Einstein accessible and interesting, it takes some liberties. Now, whenever we encountered Einstein, my son yells, "that's the guy who screams 'I LOVE MY HAIR!!!!'" which, while funny, perhaps made too much of an impression.

I love introducing my children to nonfiction characters! Thank you for the series, keep them coming!!
