

Sky Color has an interesting perspective. Looking at the sky as we think we know it in a different and interesting way. This book tells the story of opening your eyes to variety and the traditional way is not the only way to see things. A good book for children of all ages.

I like Sky Color, and also Ish, because Peter Reynolds tells a story of kids who are frustrated because their art might not be what they initially expect it to be. This was an important issue to address with my four year old perfectionist. In Sky Color, Marisol has to figure out how to paint a sky without the color blue. The text encourages kids to look beyond the traditional expectations of "Skies are blue" that the world tries to hammer into them.

Peter H. Reynolds has a way of touching children of all ages with his ability to help them open up their vision of what constitutes a sky or any other attempt at using color. As an artist, I find his books, especially the 'Dot' to free children when doing any form of painting to paint large paintings with lots of color.
